Chamber Happenings

Metropolitan Food Security Conference

Challenges of Urban Food Supply in the Mumbai Metropolitan Area

Agriculture Committee of Bombay Chamber, Netherland Agro & Food Technology Centre and GMV jointly organized the Metropolitan Food Security Conference. It focused on the challenges of Mumbai metropolitan area, implications of foreign direct investment in multi-brand retail and the Dutch perspective on establishing secure and efficient food production chains.

Facilitating trade between India, Europe and Africa via the Port of Antwerp

Logistics Committee organized a meeting with the high level logistics delegation which was led by Mr. Eddy Bruynincks, CEO, Antwerp Port Authority and Mr. Werner Van Der Cruyssen, Customs Attache, Federal Public Service Finance. The objective was to facilitate trade between India, Europe and Africa via the Port of Antwerp. The delegation addressed various related issues including Carbon Neutral Cargo Movement, Value Added Logistics for Port Competitiveness, Procedures and Policies of the Belgian Customs Authorities, Visa issuance, etc.

Workshop on Employee Retention

Human Resources Management Committee has released Employee Engagement & Employee Retention booklets they are amongst the plan series of eight pocket size booklets on different topics of HR. The objective is to serve as a toolkit for our MSME members in dealing with their daily HR issues. A workshop on "Employee Retention" was also organized during the launch focussing on various policies, best practices and the efforts taken by employers which make the employees stay and be productive.

Interactive Session on FDI Doing Business with Poland

International Trade & Commerce Committee organised a seminar in collaboration with a foreign missions on "Investment Climate in Poland" and the competitive advantages of doing business were discussed by H.E. Mr. Janusz Wach, Consulate General, Poland. Prospects for investment and the regional aid/government grants to investors and Special Economic Zones were discussed. So far the Chamber has organised such sessions with Brazil, France and Japan. The similar FDI events are organised on last Friday of every month.

Lecture on Insider Trading

Legal Affairs & IPR Committee organised a lecture by Mr. Shuva Mandal, Partner, AZB & Partners, in which he explained the term 'insider' as a person connected with the company and reasonably expected to have access to or has received Unpublished Price Sensitive Information (UPSI). He briefed on the terms viz connected person, deemed to be connected person and UPSI which prohibits insiders from dealing in securities of a company, either on his own behalf or on behalf of any other person when in possession of UPSI. He also briefed on how companies can be prevented from engaging in 'insider trading' while in possession of UPSI. He also briefed on 'Price Sensitive Information' and 'punishment for contravention' as per the provision of insider trading included in The Companies Bill. 2012.

Overseas Collaborations For Skill Development

A representative of Education & Skill Development Committee visited U.K. Colleges of Further Education, under Skills Travel Grant of UKIERI. The Chamber is keen on a formal tie up with Association of Colleges (AoC), a leading organization from UK facilitating UK-India relations in the sphere of education and training. Bombay Chamber will approach DGET, Ministry of Labour; an apex body for its official support while finalizing joint activities with U.K. institutes.
