Message from the Director General

Dear Members,

The Narendra Modi government will present its first full and perhaps its most crucial budget on 28 February 2015 against the economic backdrop of a still-nascent recovery in the economy and an even more nascent one in investment and consumption. The budget session of Parliament will commence on 23 February and conclude on 8 May with a month-long recess in between. While the budget will be presented on 28 February 2015, Bombay Chamber will be making arrangements for viewing of the Live Telecast of the Budget at its Ballard Estate office.

Soon after the Budget telecast, the President, in consultation with the Members of the Managing Committee, selected Past Presidents, the Chairmen/Co-Chairmen of the Chamber's Committees and other Experts, will formulate the viewpoint of the Chamber and communicate the same to the Press.

US President Barack Obama graced the Republic Day on 26th January, 2015 as the Chief Guest. Post the visit it is expected that the two sides will try to make progress on key issues like defence agreements, civil nuclear agreement as well as economic progress. Recently the government has asks operators to share risks on nuclear liability. While it remains to be seen whether companies agree with the government, the foreign ministry said US-Japanese companies GE-Hitachi and Westinghouse-Toshiba were part of the contact group discussions between the US and India.

Bombay Chamber appreciates the reforms proposed in the Electricity sector by the Union Government under the leadership of Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi. We believe these initiatives will enhance domestic manufacturing sector and ensure greater competition in the energy sector.
