#### Message from the Director General

Dear Members.

Wishing you a happy Financial Year 2016-17!

The RBI's next monetary policy review meeting is scheduled to be held on 5 April 2016. In its recent published Working Paper RBI argues that aggressive monetary policy actions by one country can lead to significant adverse cross border spill over on others. However, considering the domestic macroeconomic scenario, analysts and economists now expect the RBI to reduce the key policy rate from the current level of 6.75 per cent by at least 25 basis point. The reduced 'cost of capital', in turn, will help to boost private investment, which is one of the key components of aggregate demand growth of a nation. More importantly, growth in capital goods imports, which partially proxies for investment, has decelerated in India sharply from about 12 percent in April 2015 to barely positive territory recently. Let us hope for the best from the forthcoming policy announcement.
