Message from the Director General

Dear Members and Friends,

On May 29, 2017, 'The India Development Update' published by the World Bank claims that India is expected to remain the fastest growing economy in the world. The Report further argues that in India not only economic fundamentals are strong, but reform momentum continues. Also, GST, which is on track for implementation in the second quarter of the fiscal year, is expected to raise more revenue in the long term. However, on the economic front, while agriculture growth delivered in 2016-17, investment growth remains subdued, partly because of performance of Banking Sector.

As far as economic growth is concerned, on May 31, 2017, India's Central Statistics Office (CSO), in its quarterly estimates of national income accounts for Q4 of 2016-17 reaffirms the fact that the growth of real gross value added (GVA) for 2016-17 has been pegged at 6.6 per cent, 0.1 percentage point lower than the second advance estimates released in February, 2017. This is to be mentioned along with the fact that, on June 7, 2017 the RBI in its Second Bi-monthly Monetary Policy Statement of 2017-18 decided to keep the policy rate unchanged with a neutral stance, thereby impacting the growth effect that could arise from reduced rates.

The RBI also observed that the implementation of Union Budget proposals should result in private investment as business environment improves with structural reforms, including the GST, the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, and the abolition of the Foreign Investment Promotion Board. On the down side, global political risks remain elevated and could materialize.

Regarding recent events, on June 19, 2017 the Bombay Chamber organized its 181st Annual General Meeting. Mr. Ajay Tyagi, Chairman, Securities & Exchange Board of India graced the occasion as Keynote Speaker and Mr. Ishaat Hussain, Director, Tata Sons Ltd. delivered the Address by Guest of Honor. They spoke eloquently on "Securities Markets-Major Trends & Challenges" and on "Corporate Governance".

Several other events have also been organized. Mention may be made of "Half-day Seminar on GST", Certificate Course on 'Network security ,Penetration Testing & Cyber Forensics', Workshop on 'Opportunities of Doing Business in Third Countries: Merchanting Trade, etc. In the month of July we are going to organize some more events on other emerging issues like 'Virtual Reality & Augmented Reality-A future of Technology', 'Exploring the Future Possibilities of Using AR & VR for Various Industries', 'Bit Coin & Block Chain Technology', 'REX & ECGC', ' Revisiting the Role of Information Technology in Economic Growth' etc.
