Quick Facts & Figures:


- 40% of all cancers detected in India are oral cancers

The Psycho-oncology take on Tobacco Control

Patient A

- 54 year old male, diagnosed twice with Ca Tongue
- Smoker for 40 years
- Had to be told by surgeon to quit tobacco

Patient B

- 48 year old male, having cancer like symptoms.
- No disease detected at this point of time.
- Questioned consultant whether tobacco use could be cause of symptoms.

Patient C

- Healthy individual
- Regular smoker
- Heard awareness talk and realized risk to self and others around
- Voluntarily seeked assistance to quit
