CP/XI(6)/144/(Prohibitory Order)/2021

THE COMMISSIONER OF POLICE, GREATER MUMBAI ORDER (UNDER SECTION 144 OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE CODE, 1973)

- 1. Whereas, in exercise of powers conferred under Section 2 of the Epidemic Diseases Act 1897 read with enabling provisions of the National Disaster Management Act 2005, the Government of Maharashtra, issued directions vide Notification No. DMU/2020/CR.92/DisM-1, Dated: 13th April 2021 ("Break the Chain") to take certain emergency measures to prevent and contain the spread of Covid-19 virus and to enforce these measures throughout the state.
- 2. Whereas, the Government of Maharashtra, issued directions vide Notification No. DMU/2020/CR.92/DisM-1, Dated: 21st April 2021, 29th April 2021, 12th May 2021, 30th May 2021, 04th June 2021, 25th June 2021, 19th October 2021 and No. Corona 2021 / C.R.366 / Arogya-5, Dated: 02nd August 2021, 11th August 2021 and 24th September 2021, to continue emergency measures to prevent and contain the spread of Covid-19 virus, and to extend and modify the restrictions that have been imposed from time to time,
- 3. Whereas, the Government of Maharashtra, has issued directions vide Notification No. DMU/2020/CR.92/DisM-1, Dated 27th November 2021, superseding all earlier orders by the State Government with regard to imposition of restrictions for preventing the transmission of the Covid19 virus and decreeing with immediate effect that all economic, cultural, social, sports and entertainment activities will now be allowed as per the normal timings decided by various local or other competent authorities before the advent of the Covid19 pandemic, subject to certain specific conditions,
- 4. THEREFORE, I, Chaitanya S., Dy. Commissioner of Police (Operations), Greater Mumbai, and Executive Magistrate, vide powers conferred upon me u/sec 144 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 (Act II of 1974) r/w the order of Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai, dated 23/12/1959 u/s 10 sub section (2) of the Maharashtra Police Act, 1951 (Mah. Act XXII of 1951), as I am satisfied that Greater Mumbai continues to be threatened with the spread of Covid-19 virus and it is imperative to continue with measures to prevent and contain the spread of virus, with a view to prevent danger to human life, health or safety, and to break the chain of transmission of virus effectively, do hereby prohibit the violation of the specific conditions laid down in the Notification No. DMU / 2020 / CR.92 / DisM-1, Dated 27th November 2021, as follows:
 - Covid Appropriate Behaviour (CAB), as defined in the Notification, will be observed by all.
 - All persons connected with the organisation of any program, event etc as well as service providers and participants, visitors, guests, customers shall be fully vaccinated, as defined in the Notification,

- Any shop, establishment, mall, event, gathering etc. must be manned by fully vaccinated persons and all visitors, customers for such places shall be fully vaccinated.
- 4. All public transport shall be used only by fully vaccinated persons,
- All persons travelling into Maharashtra shall be either fully vaccinated or carry a RT-PCR test valid for 72 hours.
- 6. In case of any program or event or activity or gathering:
 - a. In a closed space: people up to 50% of the capacity only to be allowed,
 - b. In an open space: people up to 25% of the capacity only to be allowed,
 - If total number of people present exceeds 1 thousand, then the local disaster management authority will have to be informed of the same,
- 5. This order shall come into force, in the areas under the control of the Commissioner of Police, Greater Mumbai, from 00.00 hrs on 16th December 2021 and will remain in force till 24.00 hrs on 31st December 2021, unless withdrawn earlier. The earlier order in this regard Dated 13th December 2021 is hereby withdrawn with immediate effect.
- 6. Any person contravening this order shall be punishable under Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code 1860 in addition to penal provisions under the Epidemic Diseases Act 1897 and National Disaster Management Act 2005 and other legal provisions as applicable.
- 7. As the notice can not be served individually on all concerned, the order is hereby passed ex-parte. It shall be published for the information of the Public, through the Press, or by affixing copies on the Notice Boards of the Police Stations and offices of the Divisional ACsP and Zonal DCsP.
