



PROCUREMENT NOTICE

OPEN INTERNATIONAL BIDDING SUPPLY OF LONG GRAIN WHITE RICE PROCUREMENT REFERENCE: STC/IFB/2025/181

- 1. The State Trading Corporation (STC) is inviting bids from eligible bidders for the Supply of Long Grain White Rice for the period covering **01** April to **30** June **2025** as per requirements contained in the bidding document.
- 2. Bids must be submitted online on the e-Procurement System (e-PS) by **04 February 2025 up to 14:00 hours** (Mauritian Time) at latest.
- 3. Bidders who have submitted bids online by the closing date and time, shall decrypt and re-encrypt their bids on **04 February 2025** as from **15:01 hours** (Mauritian Time) till **06 February 2025** at **14:00 hours** (Mauritian Time).
- 4. Bids will be opened on **06 February 2025 as from 14.01 hours** (Mauritian Time) and the result of the bids will be available accordingly on the e-PS.
- 5. Interested Bidders should register by signing up on the e-PS of the Government of Mauritius on https://eproc.publicprocurement.govmu.org in order to participate in the bidding exercise and download the bidding documents, Reference Number STC/IFB/2025/181.
