Dr. Bhaskar Chatterjee, Former Secretary to Govt. of India and Currently Senior Advisor, Deloitte India and Dua Consulting

He is widely acclaimed as the Father of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) in India. He was instrumental in framing and issuing the CSR guidelines for Public Sector Enterprises (PSEs) in April, 2010. Thereafter, he played a major role in the inclusion of Section 135 in the Companies Act of 2013 and in the framing of the rules thereafter. As the Director General & CEO of the Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs (IICA), he spearheaded the National Foundation for Corporate Social Responsibility (NFCSR). He has spoken and lectured on the subject of CSR and Sustainability at a very large number of National and International forums over the last decade. Dr. Chatterjee is closely associated with the Sustainable Development Goals and the entire national effort for carrying forward the implementation process. He coordinates closely with the United Nations Global Compact and the Niti Aayog. Dr. Chatterjee is a highly respected management practitioner, theorist and teacher. He has written and lectured over many years on issues of social and sustainable development, corporate responsibility and human resources.

As a member of the **United Nations Global Compact Governing Council**, he has been associated with all the major national and international initiatives on sustainability, SDGs and ESG.

As CEO of the Anil Agarwal Foundation of the Vedanta Group, he was associated with the Company's initiatives for reducing carbon emissions to zero by 2050, environmental stewardship, introducing innovations for evolving greener business models and taking steps to achieving net water positivity by 2030. In this role, he was also coordinating and overseeing the entire gamut of CSR activities carried out by the Vedanta Group across 16 Business Units. He supervising the four National Priority Programs in the sectors of education and nutrition for women and children, rural health, animal welfare and women's empowerment. A former civil servant, he served for forty one years in the government. His parent cadre was Odisha. He held many distinguished positions in the State and Central Governments. He currently, *Chairs the*

National Committee for Formulating the Indian National Standards for ESG. This Committee has been set up by the Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS), Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Govt. of India.

He is Chairman of the Board & Co-Founder of the Indian School of Public Policy. He is also Chairman of the Centre for Civil Society and CORO and a Co-Founder of Take Charge, a mentoring programme for Catholic youth in Mumbai. Luis and his wife, are #LivingMyPromise signatories, where they have pledged to give away at least 50% of what they have to charity during their lives or in their wills. He is also on the board of Educate Girls and an advisor to non-profits like Sunbird Trust, 17000 Ft Foundation, Raah Foundation, RA Foundation, Public Affairs Forum of India, Atlas Network and SNEHA. At the University of Chicago, he is a Trustee of the University of Chicago Trust in India, member of the Global Leaders Group and the Advisory Council of the Rustandy Center for Social Sector Innovation at Chicago Booth and member of the Society Advisory Committee of the Leadership & Society Initiative. Luis is Chairman of ManipalCigna Health Insurance, Senior Advisor at Morgan Stanley and on the board of L&T Technology Services. He is also an advisor to L&T SuFin. He has been involved in setting up 2 companies - HDFC Bank and IDFC Private Equity and two non-profits – Indian School of Public Policy and Take Charge. Luis received an MBA from the Booth School of Business at The University of Chicago and is a member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.

He is a **member of several expert committees of the Government of Maharashtra**, a **faculty for public health fellowship programs**, and serves on boards including **Narayana Health**

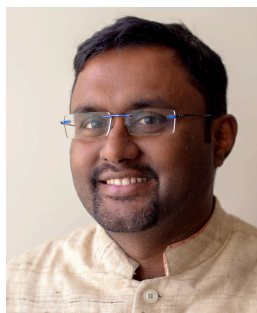
